#### Black Bart



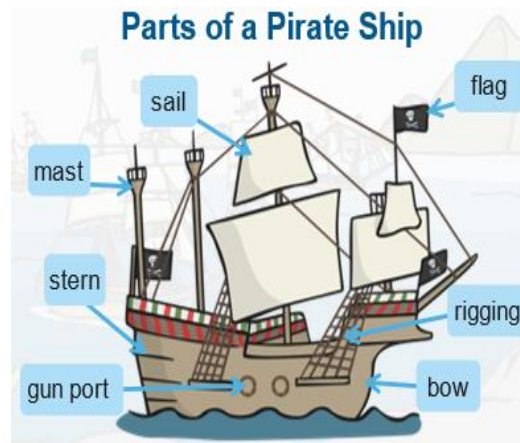
Born: 17th May 1682

Word	Definition
<b>sail</b>	The sails of a ship were made from strong fabric. They would collect the wind that blew into them to move the ship forwards.
<b>flag</b>	The pirate flag was traditionally a black flag with a white skull and crossbones. It showed other sailors that there were pirates on board.
<b>rigging</b>	The rigging was made from lots of ropes. Pirates used the rigging like ladders to climb higher up the ship and reach the crow's nest.
<b>stern</b>	The stern was the back of the ship.
<b>bow</b>	The bow (rhymes with 'now') was the front of the ship.
<b>gun port</b>	The gun ports were holes in the side of the ship which could be opened so the cannons could be fired at other ships.
<b>mast</b>	Masts were large wooden poles. Some ships had platforms at the top of a mast called a 'crow's nest' which pirates could use to look out over long distances.

Continent	A continent is a large solid area of land. There are 7 continents on Earth. (Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Australia).
Ocean	An ocean is an area of salty water. There are 5 oceans. (Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Southern and Arctic).
